RE-ENROLLMENT STARTS NEXT WEEK

Beginning Monday, February 1 and running through Tuesday, February 16 students CURRENTLY ENROLLED at Renaissance will have the opportunity to re-enroll for next school year. It is essential that every family return re-enrollment paperwork to hold a spot for the 2021-22 school year. Re-enrollments after Tuesday, February 16 cannot be guaranteed a spot for next school year. We LOVE our students and families and do not want anyone to miss out on this opportunity. If you re-enroll and then move or decide to attend another school later, all you have to do is call the school and your spots will go to someone on the waiting list. However, if you do not re-enroll your child is not guaranteed a spot next year.

Applications for new students in the 2021-22 school year and kindergarteners will take place Monday, March 1 through Monday, March 15. Enrollment applications will be available through the office during this time. At the end of this period of open enrollment, if there are more applicants than open spots for next year a lottery will take place. Again, if you know of others thinking they would like to attend RPSA next year, this is the time to complete an application. All applications that come after March 15th will be placed on a waiting list in the order they are received.

KINDERGARTEN ROUND UP

New kindergarteners for the 2021-22 school year and their families should plan to complete paperwork during open enrollment in March. Families can call at any time to sign up to receive updates leading up to March. We will be holding family tours during open enrollment as part of round up this year. Tours will be individual or small groups to adhere with safety guidelines while still showing new families around our school.
