

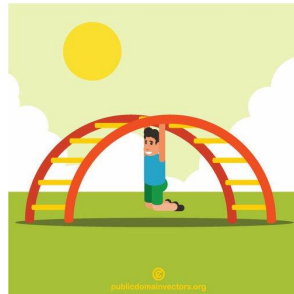

2020-21 CHROMEBOOK RETURNS



All school issued chromebooks and chargers need to be returned at the end of the school year. Students attending school in person should bring both their chromebook and charger to school on the last day, Thursday, June 10. Families of virtual students can drop off chromebooks at the school office between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Friday, June 11 or Monday, June 14. Please call Ms. Tina in the school office at (989) 773-9889 to make alternate arrangements if those dates do not work for you.

As noted in the [chromebook home use agreement](#), the following fees will apply to missing or damaged chromebooks. Fees can be paid via check or cash at the school office.

- Screen or keyboard repairs typically cost \$100. Touchscreen repairs are typically \$140.
- Chromebook replacement typically costs \$250.
- Missing charge cords typically cost \$30.
