We want to remind all families that both in school and distance learning is required daily this year. Attendance at school or through the virtual platforms (Google Classroom, Google Meet and/or Seesaw) are required of all students every school day. Thought we may not all be together physically, the expectations are that all students participate daily.

Next Monday all In School students begin to come to school together every day except Wednesdays. For the next three Wednesdays our In School students will learn from home to ensure we know procedures in case we are required to all move to Distance Learning at some point this year.

Here is what we need all In School students and their families to know as we begin to come to school together:

 Please be patient. We ask that everyone pay close attention and refrain from any cell phone use in the parking lot while driving your vehicle.

- REMAIN IN THE DROP OFF AND PICK UP LINES. PLEASE DO NOT CUT THROUGH THE PARKING LOT OR CUT IN LINE TO FILL IN AN OPEN SPACE. For your own safety it is essential that all vehicles move in the same direction in a single line.
- We will be DOUBLING the number of vehicles for drop off and pick up.
 - We will remain outside until 8:15 next week to ensure there is enough time to get all vehicles through the line. It is most congested from 7:45-7:55. Come a bit later next week.
 - We provide a 35 minute window for pick up after school from 3:25-4:00. Please come later rather than earlier. Families are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED NOT TO ARRIVE BEFORE 3:25 UNLESS IT IS TO PICK UP ONLY A KINDERGARTEN STUDENT.
 - Please do not arrive before 3:20 and park in the pick up line unless you are picking up only a kindergarten student. It is unsafe to have vehicles backed up onto Isabella Road.
- Family members may NOT get out of their vehicles at drop off and pick up. Please DO NOT approach staff at this time. Our plan does not allow for any visitors or guests outside of their vehicles.
 - The office is open to visitors from 9:00-2:00 daily. Please only come during those times.


WONDERFUL NEWS TO SHARE! OUR STUDENTS CAN EAT FOR FREE!

Effective immediately, breakfast and lunch will be FREE for ALL children at Renaissance. Current guidance from the USDA indicates that these free meals will be available to our families through December 2020 or until funding runs out. If you have already made a lunch payment, we will credit your child's account unless you request a refund with Ms. Brandy. When we have to revert back to charging for lunches again, your student's free and reduced status will be effective at that point. If you have not returned your child's lunch application for this school year, please do so ASAP as the data from this application is also used for important funding for our school.

Distance Learning students are eligible weekly for a five day meal pack that comes with five breakfast and five lunches for free to all. Pick up is each Monday at the school and can be arranged by contacting Ms. Brandy at breihl@renaissancepsa.com.
