As we say goodbye to the 19/20 school year, we want to be sure that families know we intend to stay connected to all families over the summer through Seesaw. Once a week, students will receive learning opportunities through their Seesaw account. These activities are completely optional and intended to maintain learning connections over the summer. Teachers will be sending information to families about when activities will be posted each week, as well as when they will be checking Seesaw for any communication sent the previous week. Teachers will be checking Seesaw once a week, so please do not communicate time sensitive information via Seesaw. ## **SUMMER FAMILY COMMUNICATION**

Beginning next week we will move to sending a family newsletter at a minimum every other week. If input is necessary or decisions about the 20/21 school year are made along the way, we will send newsletters as needed. Please watch your text or emails for regular updates. Our goal is to keep all stakeholders informed throughout the summer. Along the way we will need your input.

## LAST WEEK'S SURVEY RESULTS

Participation in the weekly survey topped 200 responses last week. That is absolutely amazing considering this is our last week of the school year and we know families have so much going on in their lives. Thank you for your constant support!

The top two priorities identified by families as "essential" to achieve our mission and vision were

- Opportunities for "Specials" outside of the classroom with a designated staff member receiving support from 69.7% of families (140 responses).
- Class size must be kept at 25 which has been our current practice when possible receiving support from 55.2% of families (96 responses).

The top two areas families believed could be considered to for budget reductions without jeopardizing our mission and vision were

- 142 or 70.6% responded that a four day school week would be feasible for their family.
- 111 or 47.8% responded that the length of the school day could be shortened.

### THIS WEEK'S SURVEY

This week we are looking for a bit of virtual "two way communication". We miss seeing families day in and day out. We have asked simple questions which have yielded great feedback for school staff, but have not offered our families the opportunity to be heard on the topic of their choosing. So this week's survey is an opportunity for families to share any ideas or concerns with the school leadership team. With that being said, we want families to know we most likely cannot reply personally to all of the ideas that may be shared.
