### **Student Led Conferences**

Spring Student Led Conferences (SLCs) will take place on April 20th. Teachers shared a signup sheet with families via Seesaw the week of April 4th. Our goal is 100% participation for our students, so please let your child's teacher know if you need to make special arrangements. As we prepare with students at school, we'd like to share some information to help you prepare as well. Check out this helpful information about the purpose of an SLC:

An SLC is	An SLC is not
- a time for students to dive deep into their learning of one or a few pieces of work that they are proud of with teacher guidance	- the same as sending home a portfolio of work for parents to see
- a chance for parents to ask their child about their learning and provide feedback on their growth	- a one sided presentation of work
- an opportunity for students to take a leadership role in their education and share about their learning	- a time for the teacher to give a progress update
- a partnership between the student, parents, and the teacher that is led by the student (any other adults important to the child can attend too!)	- an informal parent-teacher conference

You are invited and *encouraged* to ask them questions during the conference. Here are some ideas of things you can ask about to help get a great, reflective conversation going with your child:

- 1. Ask me about my learning goals
- 2. Ask me what I have learned
- 3. Ask me what I feel most proud of
- 4. Ask me how I answered the Driving Question in my project work
- 5. Ask me about the project I worked the hardest on
- 6. Ask me how I overcame challenges I faced
- 7. Ask me to show you evidence of how I have grown
- 8. Please give me feedback

### Weather Related Delays Through June, 2022

In an effort to capture as much instructional time as possible the remainder of this school year, we have made the decision that whenever possible Renaissance PSA will not be canceling the entire school day if there are weather concerns such as fog prior to the start of the school day. Instead we will call a two hour delay to the school day and begin at 10:00am. It has been our practice to follow the lead of surrounding schools when calling weather delays and closures. This will likely continue during the winter months in years to come. However, at this point in the spring when snow and ice are unlikely, a two hour delay allows families time to take it slow getting their children to school and then make it to work. So PLEASE watch your text messages specific to Renaissance if there are further delays or cancellations for area schools as it is our intention to only delay two hours if at all possible.

### **Enrollment Update for the 2022/23 School Year**

Current students at RPSA had the opportunity to re-enroll for next school year way back in February. In March, RPSA held an open enrollment period for students wishing to enroll for the 22/23 school year. Many of our grade levels are at or near capacity which means **we already** have a few waiting lists in third and seventh grade for next year. 
# How do we get started?
