Dear RPSA Families.

Our school doors will open once again on Monday, January 11, 2021 at 7:45 a.m. Families are reminded that adults must remain in their vehicles at drop off and school begins at 8:00 a.m. We look forward to seeing our in school students face to face and to hear laughter in our hallways and classrooms.

Please remember, that all of the procedures in place prior to the building closure will remain in effect upon our return to the building.

- Masks are required to be covering a student's mouth and nose BEFORE exiting the vehicle at
 drop off. Remind your child to put on their mask correctly when you pull into the parking lot,
 before it is time to get out of the vehicle.
- **Wednesdays will remain virtual** through at least spring break. Attendance, participation and work completion are required on Wednesdays.
- Families must continue to do the <u>symptom screener each morning</u> before coming to school.
- **Symptomatic students will be sent home** and quarinting protocols will continue to be required to return to school.
- A water bottle with your child's name written on it is necessary since all drinking fountains remain shut off. Water bottle filling stations are functional.

Other important reminders to ensure your child's return goes smoothly.

- Students will go out to recess at least two times a day. **Winter clothing and boots** are required to ensure a warm experience and save our classroom carpets. A second pair of shoes/boots should be left at school.
- Ensure you are connected to your child's teacher through **Seesaw**. This is how we communicate with families.
