When you read at home with your kids, follow the **R.E.A.D.** plan.

R - Repeat Books

E - Engage and Enjoy

A - Ask Questions

D - Do More

This week we will focus on the **D: Do More**. The following are examples of activities you could do at home when reading with your child following the R.E.A.D. plan:

- ☐ **Trips to everyday places build vocabulary. Discuss what you are doing and seeing as you are going through the store, for example. “I’m here in the bakery. I can find donuts, cookies, and bread.” Ask your child, “What else do you think I could find here?”**

- ☐ **Build words. Using magnetic letters, make a three letter word on the refrigerator (cat). Have your child read the word and use it in a sentence. Every day, change one letter to make a new word. Start by changing only the beginning letter (cat, bat, hat, sat, mat, rat, pat). Then change only the ending letter (pat, pal, pad, pan). Finally, change only the middle letter (pan, pen, pin, pun).**

- ☐ **Family stories enrich the relationship between parent and child. Tell your child stories about your parents and grandparents, and when you were little. Talk about your brothers, sisters, or friends. You might even put these stories in a book and add family photographs. This could model how you write about and keep these special memories or stories. Then invite your child to tell sto**
