2021-22 ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

Re-enrollment for the 2021-22 school year began Monday, February 1 and runs through Tuesday, February 16. Students CURRENTLY ENROLLED at Renaissance have the opportunity to re-enroll for next school year. It is essential that every family return re-enrollment paperwork to hold a spot for the 2021-22 school year. Re-enrollments after Tuesday, February 16 cannot be guaranteed a spot for next school year.

Applications for new students in the 2021-22 school year and kindergarteners will take place Monday, March 1 through Monday, March 15. Enrollment applications will be available through the office during this time. At the end of this period of open enrollment, if there are more applicants than open spots for next year a lottery will take place. Again, if you know of others thinking they would like to attend RPSA next year, this is the time to complete an application. All applications that come after March 15th will be placed on a waiting list in the order they are received.

Families of kindergarteners for the 2021-22 school year can call the office at 989-773-9889 and talk to Brandy to begin the round up process. We encourage all interested families to make an appointment for March since our enrollment is limited to 50 incoming kindergarten students for next year.
