<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a time for students to dive deep into their learning of one or a few pieces of work that they are proud of with teacher guidance. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the same as sending home a portfolio of work for parents to see.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a chance for parents to ask their child about their learning and provide feedback on their growth 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a one sided presentation of work
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - an opportunity for students to take a leadership role in their education and share about their learning 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a time for the teacher to give a progress update
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a partnership between the student, parents, and the teacher that is led by the student (any other adults important to the child can attend too!) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - an informal parent-teacher conference

We are so excited to see each of you and give our students this amazing opportunity to grow in their understanding and ownership of the learning process. Look for a set of suggested questions to ask at your child's SLC in next week's newsletter.

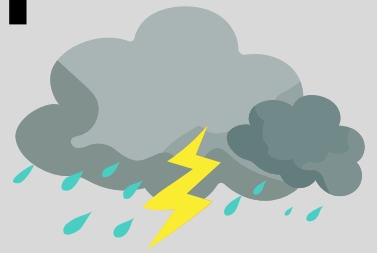


Be Safe Be Responsible

Inclement Weather Indoor Pickup



Procedures for Indoor Pickup in cases of rain or severe weather:

- **Option 1:** Stay in your vehicle and drive through the pick up lane
 - If using the pick-up lane, please place your laminated sign with students names in the front passenger window (new signs will come home soon)
 - A staff member will meet cars at the entrance and radio to the classroom teacher for students to be sent out the front doors. Cars should stay in the pick up lane while waiting for their student
- **Option 2:** Park and Enter the Building
 - If parking, please use one of the two crosswalks to cross the parking lot and enter the building
 - Staff will help you find your child's classroom to pick them up from inside

Attention Renaissance Families:

In the spirit of community and support for our athletes and the athletics program, the administration and athletics department encourages spectator support at all home events. If you have ever attended an athletics event here at Renaissance, you know that the atmosphere is exciting (and loud). In June of 2021, the federal government declared September 30th a national statutory holiday to coincide with Orange Shirt Day.

This day gives us all an opportunity to discuss the effects of residential schools and their legacy. The motto, "Every Child Matters" is a reminder that all children are important, everywhere and every day, including the ones left behind and the adults who are still healing.

This day is also an opportunity to learn about reconciliation-making and accepting apologies.
