 - b) Enter your student's ID number for the password
 - c) Enter your email address

To order pictures select BUY PRINTS. Please note there are separate tabs at the top of the screen for packages, single prints and photo products. If you order by the stated deadline you will not pay shipping unless you choose to have the package shipped to your home.

If you order after the deadline prices increase, you will be charged shipping and the package will be shipped to your home address.

After the picture order deadline all packages will be printed and delivered to your school or organization.
