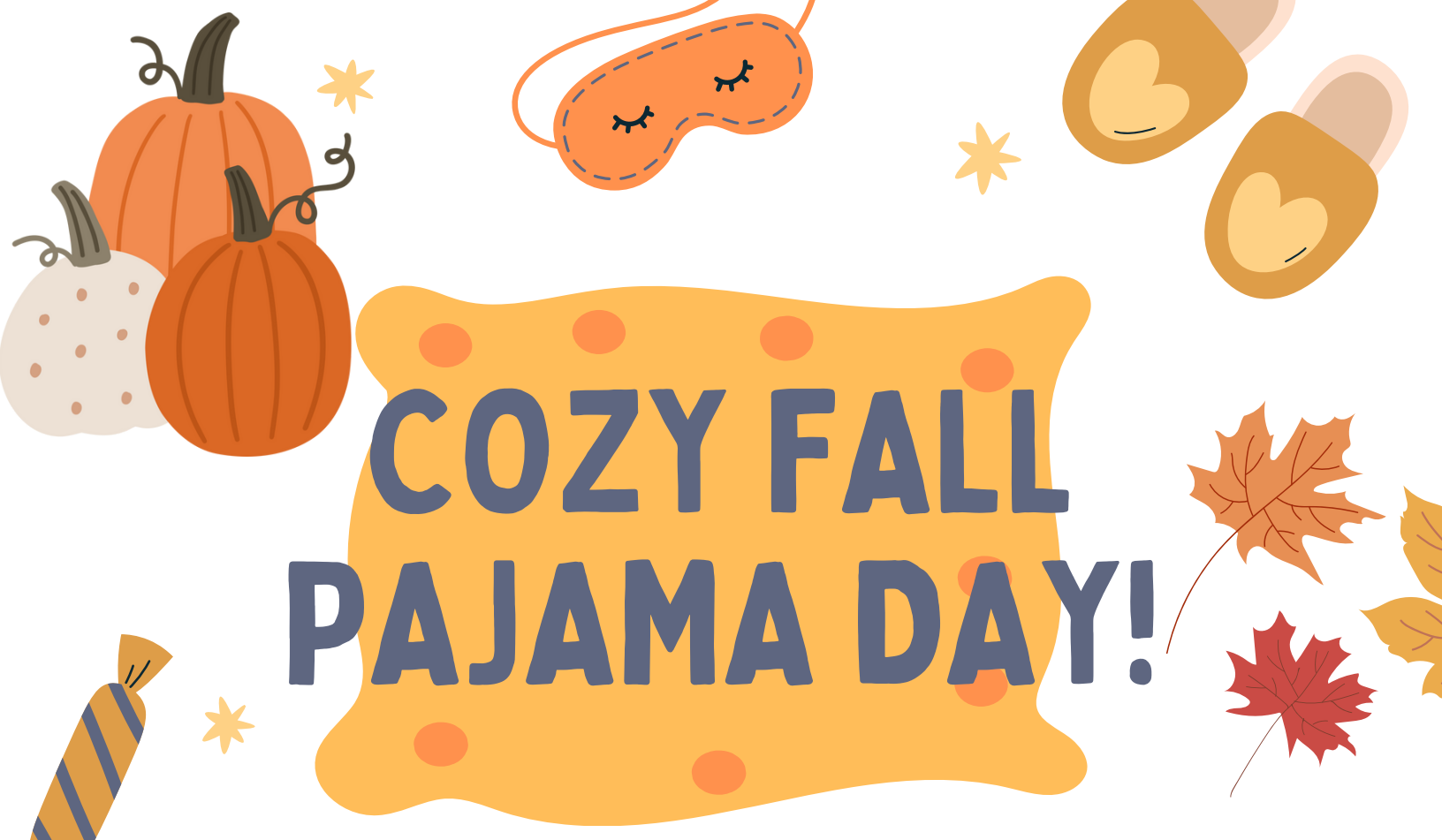


Be Safe Be Responsible

We're excited to celebrate these amazing students who received a Shout Out this week!

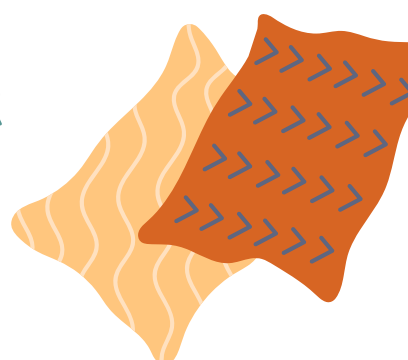

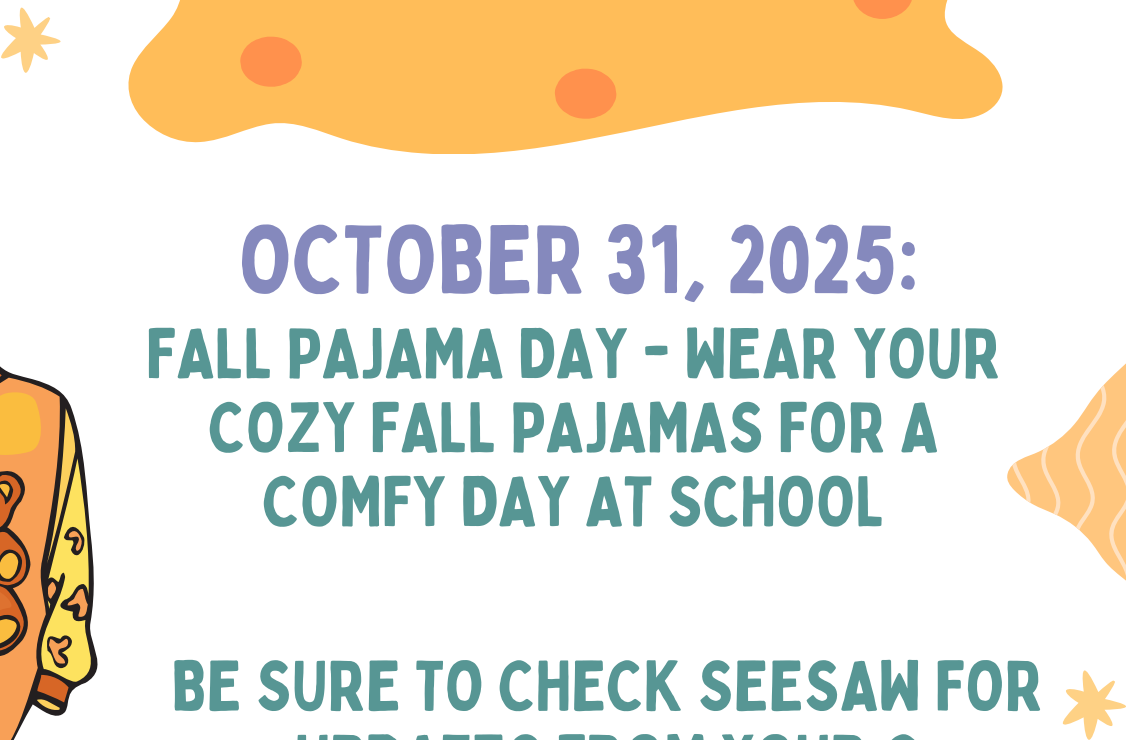

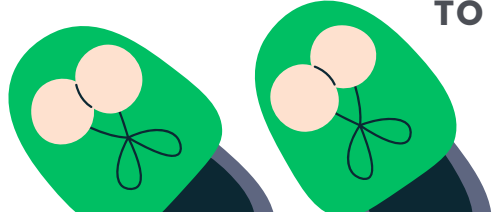
