Distribution will be by appointment ONLY again this year (You must have an appointment to receive toys). You can do a drive thru appointment on any of those days but you still MUST have an appointment.

DISTRIBUTION WILL BE AT THE YOUTH FOR CHRIST BUILDING IN MT. PLEASANT (THE OLD COKE BUILDING) AT 1200 W HIGH ST, MT. PLEASANT MI, 48858.

- ONLY the Parent/Legal Guardian can register a child
 - If the parent/legal guardian cannot shop, they can designate someone else to come in their place on the registration form
 - Proper documentation for both parent & child will still be required for the appointment as well as a letter giving permission to the designee to shop in the parent/legal guardian's place
- Each Family needs to be registered and have their own appointment set up.
 - If you live in a split home and are unmarried, EACH person needs their own registration for their children
- No children will be allowed this year. This is to ensure that we stay within the building capacity rules.
