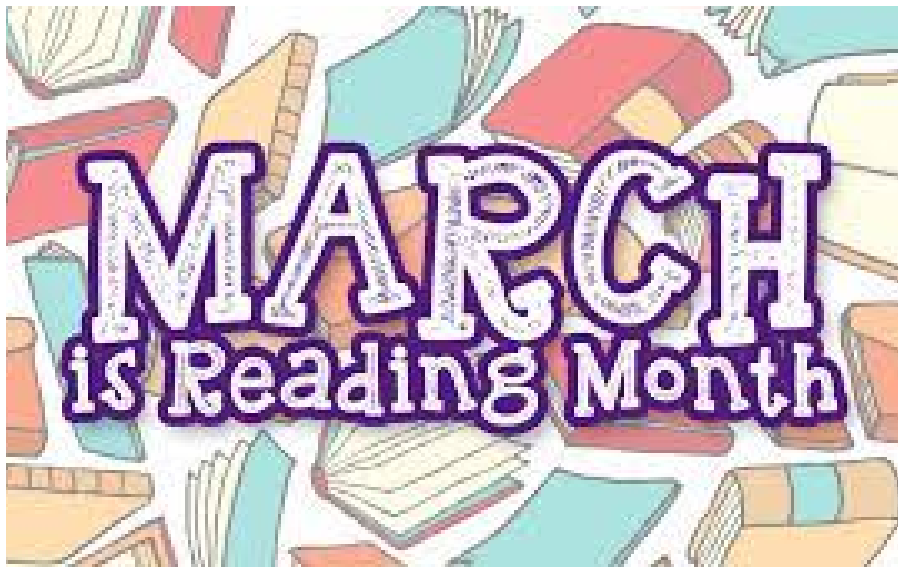
Hello RPSA Families,
