Beginning September 1, 2024, Renaissance Academy will begin using a new platform to deliver messages such as school closings, newsletters, and other important announcements. The new platform, called School Messenger, is similar to our current system. For the most part you should not notice any significant changes in the way you receive messages.

While most things will remain the same, there is one important change you need to be aware of. <u>FAMILIES MUST OPT-IN IF THEY WISH TO RECEIVE SMS TEXT MESSAGES.</u> Families who do not opt-in to the SMS Text messages will receive announcements via email only. While opting-in is not required, doing so will ensure optimal communication between school and families as it provides one more layer of messaging.

Families who wish to opt-in will need to do so from each phone on which they wish to receive SMS Text messages, and you can opt-in at any time. Instructions for opting-in are found below.

Our school utilizes the SchoolMessenger system to deliver text messages, straight to your mobile phone with important information about events, school closings, safety alerts and more.

You can participate in this free service\* just by sending a text message of "Y" or "Yes" to our school's short code number, 67587.

You can also opt out of these messages at any time by simply replying to one of our messages with "**Stop**".



SchoolMessenger is compliant with the Student Privacy Pledge $^{TM}$ , so you can rest assured that your information is safe and will never be given or sold to anyone.

Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes:

SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a "text message". Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as "short code" texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers. If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.
