RAMS Pride Update

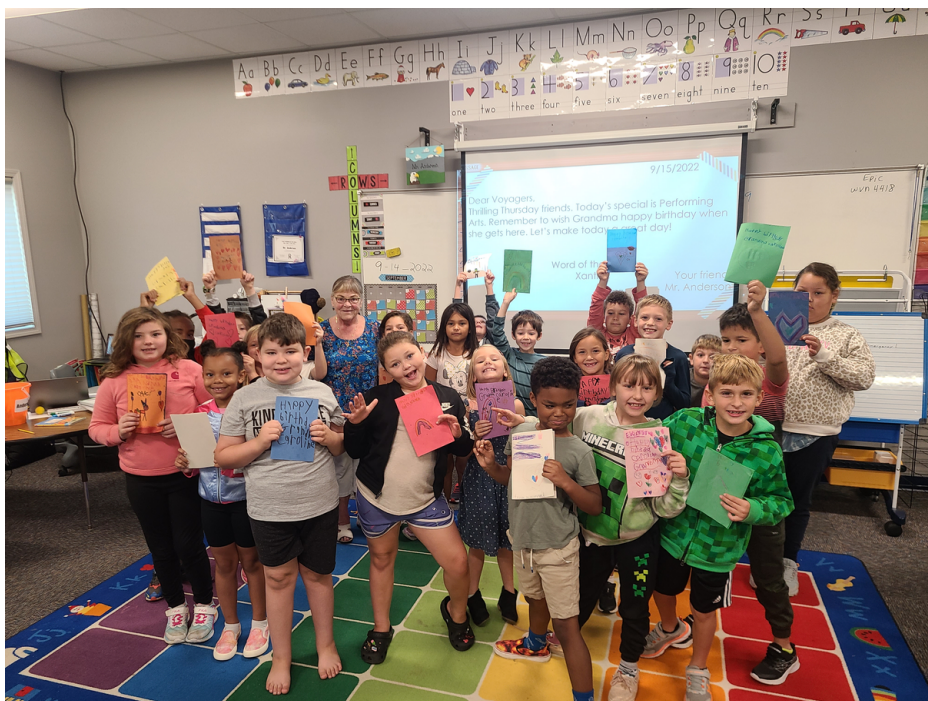
We have officially kicked off RAMS Pride.
