All families should be connected to Seesaw for updates and communication from your child's classroom. If you have not received messages or updates from your child's teacher yet, please

reach out to them. The Seesaw App often needs to be updated on your device after a summer without use.

It is our hope that all families check Seesaw at least once a day. This is our primary form of communication from your child's teacher and all classroom information, upcoming events, etc. will be shared with parents through Seesaw.

Did you know we offer a before school program?

Supervision is available from 7:00-7:40 for those who want to drop off early. See details below!

Before and After School

We are very excited to offer both before and after school care this school year. These programs do hold a child care license and must follow all licensing rules:

- Cost
 - \$5 per day Before School
 - 7:00am 7:45am
 - \$20 per day After School OR \$50 weekly
 - end of school 5:30pm
 - Kindergarten through 6th grade only
 - to meet staffing rules, families must register and pay the week prior (no drop ins)
 - stop into the front office for registration paperwork

Inclement Weather

In the instance of an indoor pickup due to inclement weather, please see the below procedures for getting students picked up in a timely manner and keeping them safe

- Parents may choose to park and walk up to the building where a staff
 member will meet you and call for your child OR you may use the pickup
 lane to drive along the sidewalk and wait for your child
- When you enter the parking lot, please expect to stop and tell the staff
 member at the entrance your child's name and the name of their teacher
 - We will provide all families with a laminated card to put in your front window to help with this
- Staff in the parking lot and at the front entrance will radio to the classroom to have your student come to the front of the building
- Staff will escort children to vehicles in the pickup lane and help them get in safely
- Families are asked to still use the crosswalks when parking and walking up for students - it can be very hard to see in a rainy parking lot and crossing at other areas is not safe
- Please expect to take a little more time for pickup on these days, as we will
 move students as quickly as possible but it does take time
- Again, we will have free supervision available until 4:00pm so families are encouraged to wait a little past dismissal time to arrive for your student.
