We have seen an increase in stomach related illnesses over the last week. Please review this information from the District Health Department regarding the spread of Norovirus. Please remember students may not return to school until they have been vomit and diarrhea free for at least 24 hours.

NOROVIRUS

Norovirus is very contagious and causes vomiting and diarrhea. People of all ages can get infected and sick with norovirus. Most people with norovirus illness get better within 1 to 3 days, but they can still be contagious for a few days after.

Norovirus spreads very easily within schools. To prevent getting and spreading norovirus, students and school staff should wash their hands well with soap and water; hand sanitizer alone does not work well against norovirus

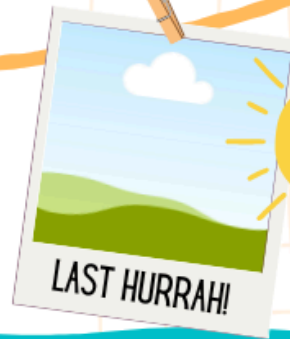
