NOROVIRUS

Norovirus is very contagious and causes vomiting and diarrhea. People of all ages can get infected and sick with norovirus. Most people with norovirus illness get better within 1 to 3 days, but they can still be contagious for a few days after.

Norovirus spreads very easily within schools. To prevent getting and spreading norovirus, students and school staff should wash their hands well with soap and water: hand sanitizer alone does not work well against norovirus
