Parking Lot Procedures

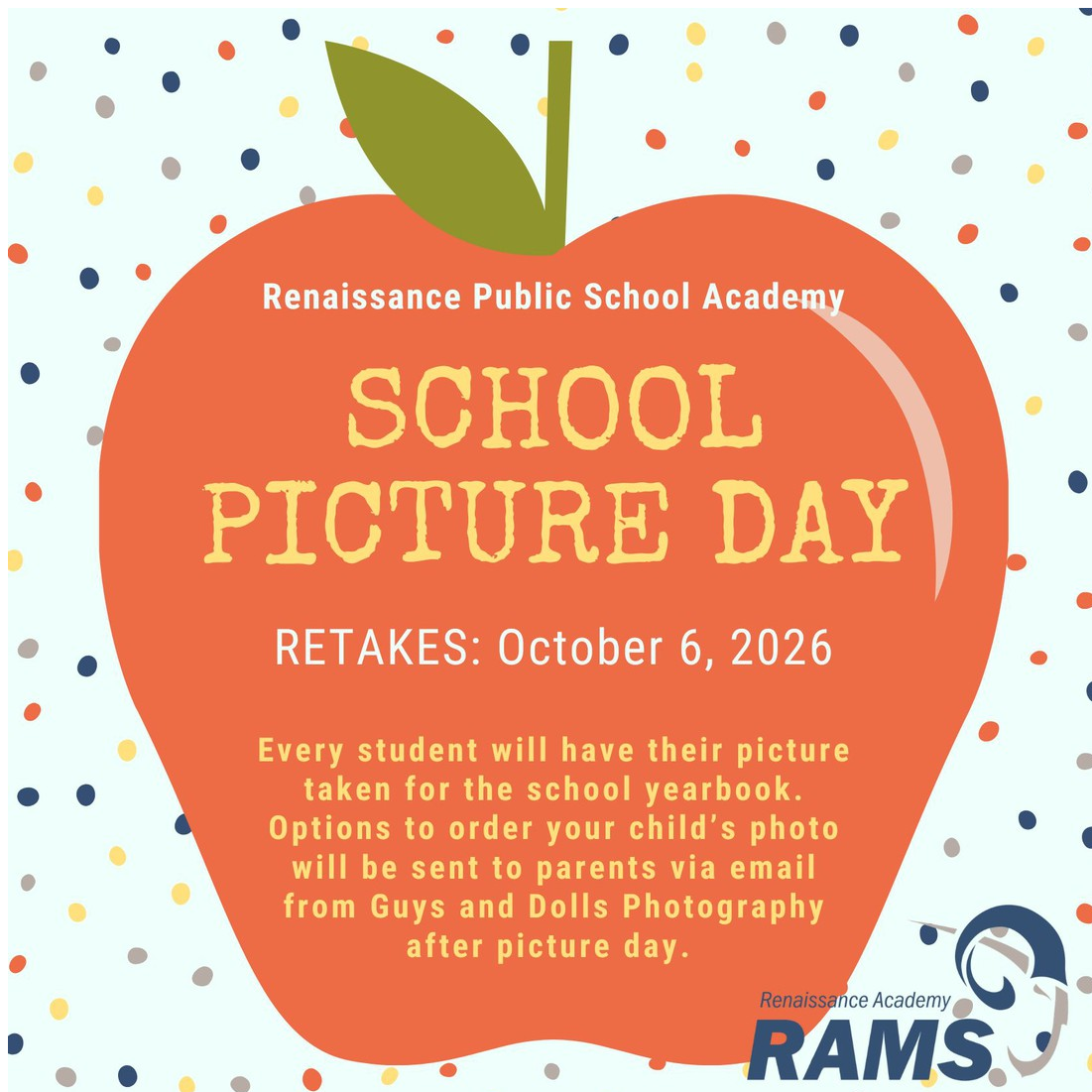
In order to keep our students and staff safe, we ask that families please remember the following procedures for drop off and pick up:

- School doors open at 7:40am. Please have children stay in the car until this time. Students should not be left unsupervised outside the front door.
 - There should be 2 lanes of traffic around the parking lot. The right lane is for dropping off and picking up along the sidewalk. The left lane is for driving through to park or exit. Please DO NOT GO AROUND BOTH LANES OF TRAFFIC. This is a major safety hazard for students and families walking at the crosswalks. Students may not exit the vehicle in the inner lane. Parents must be either in the drop off lane or parked in a parking space when students exit the vehicle.
 - The north end of the parking lot is for staff parking only. Please do not park in that area at the end of the day, as this would require you to drive through the bussing area where children are crossing.
 - We have staff on duty for supervision until 4:00pm daily (2:30pm on Wednesday). If you are able, we recommend waiting until 3:40pm to pick up your child. This spreads out the flow of traffic and the parking lot is much less congested at that time.

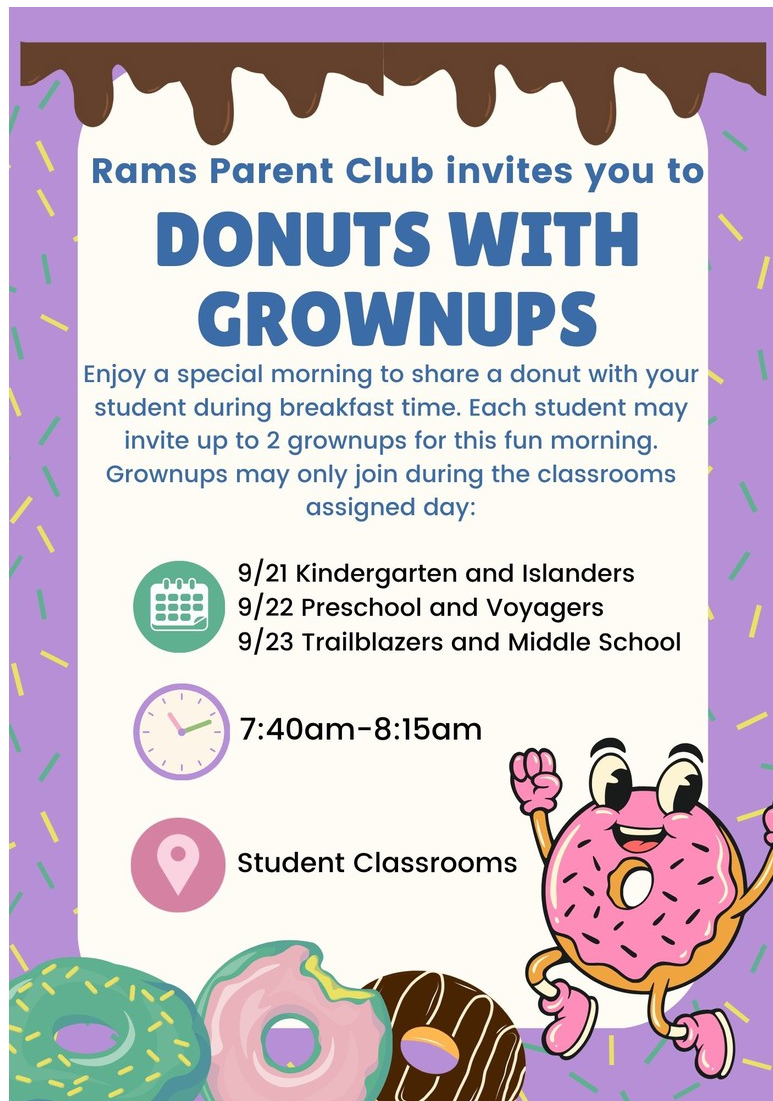
